A Happy Youth.
In the Orphans' Court yesterday Judge Ashman granted the petition of Edwin T. Coxe, guardian of Samuel R. Henderson, a minor of eighteen years, who has an estate of \$68,408 26. The petition asked that young Henderson be allowed \$350 out of his estate, with which to purchase a horse, saddle and bridle. \$350 a year was also allowed for keeping of the horse. The relatives of the minor thought it proper for him to have a horse, his habits being very good.

Minors' Allowances.
In the Orphans' Court on Saturday, Judge Ashman made an order in the estate of James H. Henderson, a minor of nineteen years, granting to the latter, who has an estate of \$73,948, a yearly allowance of \$2500. The minor had formerly been allowed \$1200 per annum, but having married on the 14th of August last, he sought to have an additional allowance in order to go to housekeeping.
