

A review of Marblehead early Vital Records showed the following: 1. Sarah Gale Bessom, wife of Richard died in Sept 1802

Were there any children born of a Richard and Sarah Bessom after 1802 that would indicate the marriage of a couple of child-bearing age? None found

2. A marriage of a Richard Bessom to Sarah Calley two months after the death of Sarah Gale Bessom

4. There was the birth of a Sarah Calley 80+ years previous to the death of Richard Bessom's widow

Was Sarah Calley a widow? No previous marriagees recorded for her.

3. The death of Sarah Bessom, the widow of Richard at about 84 years of age
