- Item I Give also to my Son Nathl. Bartlett one Cow Leap in & Made Division & give him one Copper kettle freely to Enjoy to him and his Heirs and Assigns for Ever after my wife Decease —
- Item I Give to my Son Thomas Bartlett my Working Horses barn & all & Remainder of Land Reserving himself or his one Cow Leap in the Made Division and all my Land Lying between James Skinner Land & my Brother Thomas Bartlett Land in & plain farm to him & his Heirs and Assigns freely to Enjoy for Ever after my wife Decease —
- Item I Give to My son in Law Thomas Wood & his wife Elizabeth who's Six Acres of Land Bounded on & Land of John Harding & also on a right way Leading to Boston or Also half a Cow Leap in the Upper Division to them & if their and Assigns freely to Enjoy for Ever after my wife Decease —
- Item I Give to My son in Law Philip Ashton and his wife Sarah who's Six Acres of Land Bounded on Land of Thos. Harding and so to the way back Against Capt. Smith's Land or Also half a Cow Leap in & Upper Division Turning to the Land of Thomas Woodson to them and if their and Assigns freely to Enjoy for Ever after my wife Decease —
- Item I Give to my Grand Daughter Sarah Bartlett Daughter of my son John Bartlett Decease fifty Pounds in Bills of Credit and to be paid as followeth twenty five pounds by my son Nathl. Bartlett or his Heirs and Assigns five pounds by my son Thomas Bartlett or his Heirs and Assigns as the Come of Age
- Item I Give to my well Beloved wife all my Moveables that as the Menphoned freely to Enjoy for Ever —
- Item I Give to my son John Nathl. Bartlett Thomas Bartlett Elizabeth Wood & Sarah Ashton all my Right of Land Lying at the Eastward to be Divided Equal Like Amongs them to them their Heirs and Assigns for Ever

Likewise I do Make my two Sons Nathl. Bartlett and Thomas Bartlett my Sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament And I do hereby Disallow Revokes & Decumts all and Every former Testament Will Legacies & Bequest and Executors by me in ways before Named Will of bequeath Notifying and Confirming this and No other to be my last will and Testament The Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal the Day and year Above Written —

- In the Name of God Amen I Robert Nicholson of Marblehead in the County of Essex Shoresman do hereby make my last will and Testament
- Item I resign my soul to God and my body to the ground to be buried at the Discretion of my Executors —
- Item I will that my Debts and all other Charges shall be paid by my Executors
- Item I Give to my son John if he be living my Cow Leap in the Upper Division of the Common Lands of Marblehead to him his Heirs and Assigns forever and if my said son be not living then I Give the said Lease to his Children their Heirs and Assigns forever to be equally divided between them —
- Item I Give to my son Uriah his Heirs & Assigns for ever all my Two dwelling Houses & Barn situate in said Marblehead with my Land thereto adjoining, also my Gun & Sword and one of my Beds which he shall choose he leaving to my daughter, the personal Legacies herein after named Appointed to be paid to my Daughters by my Executors —
- Item I Give to my Daughter Martha Sixty pounds and Tenor Bills of Credit to be paid by my Executors within Twelve months next after my Decease
- Item I Give to my Daughter Mary the wife of Thomas Brown Forty pounds and Tenor Bills of Credit to be paid within one year after my Decease by my Executors —

Item I Give to my Daughter Abigail the wife of Joseph
Davis my other feather Bed And Tippet, Bunderin
 and Tenor Bills of Credit to be paid her within one
 year after my Decease by my Executors
 Item I Give my personal Estate not herein before bequeathed
 I Give to my 3 Daughters Martha Mary and
 Abigail to be Equally divided between them
 Finally I hereby Constitute and Appoint my said son
 Josiah and my wellbeloved friend Joseph Ricket
 of said Marblehead Shoreman the Executors
 of this my last Will & Testament hereby revoc-
 king all Wills by me heretofore made In
 Witness whereof I do hereunto set my hand
 and Seal this Thirtieth Day of March in
 the year of our Lord seventeen hundred Forty Eight

 in Manner following vizt

I make my loving wife Obedience Bartlett and
 my son-in-law Robert Deal of Salem in the County of
 Essex County, Executors of this my Testament and order
 them as soon as may be after my decease, to discharge
 all my Just debts & funeral Charges out of my per-
 sonal Estate

Item I Give to my said wife, my Negro Boy Cesar to her
 own proper use and behoof forever also I Give her
 the free use and Improvement of all my Estate Real &
 personal (after payment of my debts & funeral
 Charges as aforesaid) so long as she shall remain my Widow
 she keeping the same, & every part thereof in good Repair
 and after her death or Remarriage (which of them
 may first happen) I Give the whole of my said
 Estate in Manner following that is today to my
 Grandson Robert Deal & Nathanael Deal to each
 of them One Mileh Low or the value thereof, And
 my Houfing & Land, And the rest of my Stock and
 moveables I Give in equal Halves to my Two

Daughters vizt Mary Deal and Elizabeth Deal and to
 their heirs forever, and I order that in the division of
 the Houfing and Land Mary shall have the south west
 part and Elizabeth shall have the north east part
 thereof. In Witness whereof I the said Josiah Bartlett
 have hereunto set my hand & Seal this twenty eighth
 day of April in the seventeenth year of His Majesty
 King, Anno Domini 1744.
